The Responsibilities of a Trenton Rotarian

- Propose new members – it's a privilege and obligation to expand Trenton Rotary with civic minded members. Invite a friend or colleague to a service project or a regular meeting, introduce them to the Membership Chair and he'll take it from there.
- Roll up your sleeves, put "Service Above Self" and participate at least twice a year in a Trenton Rotary Service Project.
- Financial commitments are \$327 per quarter cover our costs and help fund our charitable giving. This amount includes all meal costs, club dues of \$75, your Rotary International dues of \$35 and your contribution of \$100 per year to the Rotary International Foundation.

Getting started in Trenton Rotary

- Use your sponsor: ask questions and get oriented to learn about Trenton Rotary and our different projects and opportunities for hands-on service.
- Introduce yourself to other Rotarians by serving as a "greeter" (a weekly tradition of welcoming fellow members one at a time by standing by the attendance sheet podium at the entrance)
- Schedule your "classification talk", a 5 to 10 minute talk about your life and/or profession to introduce yourself to your fellow members.
- Sit at different tables each week at lunch.
- Participate in a committee to help plan or implement a project.
- Experience the broader Rotary community by "making up" at other clubs and attending an event or activity sponsored by our District 7510 or RI.
- Update your personal listing in the club member database – you can upload your own photo. Login instructions will be emailed to you after we set up your account based on the information in your application.
